

- RANGE RULES -

1. All Federal, State and Local firearm laws must be obeyed.
2. In an effort to maintain a safe environment, Range Master and Range Staff must be obeyed.
3. Range Master and Range Staff have the right to inspect all firearms, ammunition and equipment.
4. Everyone must follow the Four Basic Rules of Firearm Safety at all times:
 1. Treat all guns as if they are loaded.
 2. Never point a gun at anything you are not willing to shoot or destroy.
 3. Keep your finger straight and off the trigger until your sights are on the target and you are ready to shoot.
 4. Be sure of your target, what is in line with it and what is beyond it.
5. Load and unload firearms only on the firing line and in your shooting lane.
6. All loaded firearms must be pointed at the backstop at all times.
7. All firearms must be cleared with breach open and placed in range bag when removed from the firing line.
8. Shooters must put on eye and hearing protection prior to entering the range and keep it on until after exiting the range.
9. If any problem should occur with your firearm while on the firing line, leave the firearm pointed toward the backstop on the bench in the firing station and contact the Range Safety Officer.
10. No drawing from a holster.
11. Shoot only at the target in your lane.
12. No one is allowed forward of the firing line at any time, under any circumstances.
13. Be sure you are using the correct ammunition for your firearm. Steel core, tracers, explosive, frangible or armor piercing ammunition is strictly prohibited. Shotguns are allowed with single projectile only.
14. Shooters may only collect their personal fired brass without disrupting the shooters around them. Advise Range Safety Officer upon entry if you wish to collect your spent brass.
15. No food or drink is permitted on the range.
16. No one will be permitted on the range if they are under the influence of alcohol or otherwise impaired.
17. Shooters under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian, no person under the age of 10 admitted onto the range.
18. Only one loaded firearm at a time in each lane. No other gun handling behind the firing line.
19. No open toed shoes or open tops allowed on the range.
20. Be courteous and aware of other shooters around you on the range.
21. Notify Range Safety Officer of any unsafe practices on the range.
22. All Class III firearms must be checked in at the Range Desk.
23. Black powder or muzzleloaders are permitted with smokeless powder only.
24. If there is any target malfunction, call Range Safety Officer immediately.
25. Guests renting firearms for range use agree to only use new commercial factory ammunition. **NO RELOADS IN RENTAL FIREARMS.**
